Randolph County, 3 Spring Term AD 1842

The jurats for the state upon their oaths present that Abner Hill late of the said County of Randolph labourer on the twenty fourth day of December AD 1841 with force and arms in the County aforesaid, did sell and deliver one quart of spirituous liquors to a certain slave named Isaac the property of one Priscilla Free, the said spirituous liquors not being for the owner or employer of said slave Isaac or by the order of the owner or person having the management of the said slave Isaac: against the form of the Statute in such case made and provided, and against the peace and dignity of the state.
