in all things behave h^{er} self towards h^{er} said Master for and during the said
term, as an Apprentice ought to do. And the said Willis Langford
doth covenant, promise and agree to and with the said Peter Woodlief
and his successors, that ~~he~~ the said Willis Langford
will provide and allow h^{er} said Apprentice, convenient ~~and~~ sufficient meat, drink,
lodging and apparel, and use h^{er} best endeavours to instruct h^{er} in the art and call-
ing of a _____ and also to teach h^{er} _____
to read and write before the expiration of h^{er} apprenticeship.
