 Land lying on the west side of the River same branch for the benefit of a meeting house  
 and school also in said house bounded as follows to wit beginning on a six of the stage road  
 on Andrews line running to Engham's. In Dec. 1<sup>st</sup> then W<sup>m</sup> Lehman do set out then 2<sup>d</sup> then  
 N<sup>o</sup> three 3<sup>rd</sup> N<sup>o</sup> of lot to the beginning Lion Rogers do bind my self my exec or assigns for  
 ever to the above named ground to the aforesaid Trustees for the use benefit of assembling and  
 school house by the name of new hope owned by the Baptist Society above as a church  
 give the day and date a true return
