2nd My will and desire is that all my personal property shall be sold by my executor and the debts owing to me collected; and if there shall be any surplus over and above the payment of my debts and expenses that such surplus be divided among my children as hereafter specified.


3rd I will and bequeath to ^{my} daughter Camillia wife of Daniel C. Basinger Ten dollars,

4th I will and bequeath all the ballance of my personal estate of whatever nature or kind shall be divided equally betwixt my son William Stoner, John M. Stoner, Julia Ann, wife of Levi Frick, Leah wife of John H. Bridgely, Eve Ann Lewis (widow) and Euline Ludwick (now deceased) her three children her proportionable part of said estate.

5th I will and desire my Lusty son William Stoner and Levi Frick to be my executors of this my last will and testament.
